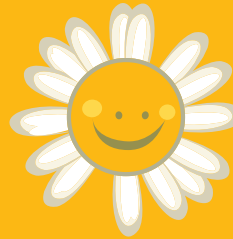


Volunteer Role: Kitchen

What is the purpose of the role?

To provide a catering and kitchen service at Cancer Fund for Children's Therapeutic Short Break Centre.

Location

What does it involve?

What skills or experience do I need?
