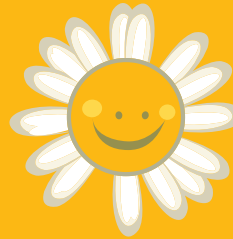


Volunteer Role: Minibus Drivers

What is the purpose of the role?

To provide transport for children and young people participating in Cancer Fund for Children residentials and group activity days.

Location

Volunteers will be asked to transport groups of children and young people who are attending residentials or group activity days from the Belfast HQ. We also require volunteers in the Newcastle area who can transport groups when on residential at weekends and during holiday periods.

Your commitment

We are looking for individuals who can volunteer during evenings and weekends for a four-hour period once a month.

We need volunteers who:

- Have a category D1 or a D1(nfhr) on their licence who have experience of driving a minibus.
- Are responsible and can work alongside staff and other volunteers taking account of the needs of children and young people impacted by Cancer.
- Will take part in training as necessary.
- Will adhere to policies and procedures with particular emphasis on Community Transport Association policies, Cancer Fund for Children health and safety and safeguarding policies.
- Will complete an Enhanced Access NI Disclosure.

- You will receive induction training to prepare you.
- You will receive support and supervision.
- You will be part of a very passionate team.
- You will be integral in providing children and young people with the opportunity to participate in group work.
- You will have the opportunity to meet new people and develop new skills.
