Tessa is our two year old daughter, the youngest of four. She has two brothers and a sister. She has been loved and adored from the moment she was born. When she was 14 months old Tessa was diagnosed with stage 4 high risk neuroblastoma.

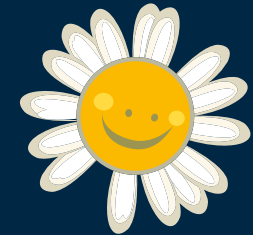
